1.) Longmont Open Financial Review, Success & Future Plans:

- Longmont Open was a huge success! The tournament had an increase of 100 more players, up from 135 last year to 235. Tim did a great job as Tournament Director. Also, a huge thanks to Jody Reenan for all her hard work and dedication towards this tournament and all the volunteers.
- The tournament ran at a net loss this year. Expenses should be down next year as we had to guess on the amount of food and t-shirts to order. Also, the LTA will not need to buy banners or tablecloths next year.

Things to look at for next year:

- Talk to the city about not holding any lessons during the tournament.
- Possibly charge \$2-\$3 for alcoholic drinks next year.
- Need volunteers for 1.5 hours before and after each day
- Possible food trucks next year
- Need to recruit 4.0 players
- Increase sponsorships

- CO Periodic Report Due by January 31 – Tony Berger will continue to take care of this.

- Socials – Laura from LAC said Rebecca might take this over. Scott and Jody will coordinate with LAC and get dates and send a blast to the members.

- Adults – 4 courts of doubles (16 player max) from 2-4 p.m. on Sundays.
 - High Schools – Scott is going to contact Silver Creek, Longmont High and Skyline to possibly start a program for Junior's so they get more playing time. LTA can reserve 5 courts at Quail for \$30.00.
- Porta Potty Removal is scheduled after Oct. 31st.
 - Backboards – Carr Park and Affolter already have plans for a new installation or renovation of the concrete. Scott and Jody suggested to our city contracts that we need one or two at Quail on courts 6 & 7.
 - QR Codes - Joyce Kelly suggested putting QR codes on the gates at local tennis courts. Joyce said it is very hard to get into the tennis community and play if you are new to the area, sport or want to join a league. This QR code could route tennis players to the LTA for Jody Reenan to review and pass along info where needed for players or teams.
